



The GrayMatters™ system is a standardized, scientifically validated program for determining whether someone has very early symptoms suggestive of Alzheimer's disease or other (reversible or irreversible) dementia. It was developed through seven years of research using over one thousand research subjects. The system measures memory and executive functioning by presenting problem-solving tasks to the subject and monitoring how the subject responds to the tasks. The subject's performance is compared to the performance of others from similar age, gender, educational, and ethnic backgrounds. The report describes the subject's performance relative to the normative sample and gives a probability statement regarding the possibility of Mild Cognitive Impairment (MCI) or early dementia.
